

Contests

Contests, or other activities involving participation by pupils and/or the granting of awards or prizes, which are sponsored by agencies outside the schools, shall not be announced, promoted, or permitted within the schools unless approved by the superintendent. The superintendent shall approve only such contests or other activities as will be of educational value to the participating pupils. He shall not approve any activity being promoted for commercial purposes, except that he may approve any scholarship contest or other activity which is sponsored by a commercial agency conducting a business which is not objectionable to any substantial group of residents of the school district, which is conducted primarily for educational rather than advertising purposes and which offers substantial awards for effort and skill, which is conducted in such manner that the competition is wholesome, and not detrimental to the educational purposes of the schools, and which is conducted in such manner that the advertising incidental thereto is not exaggerated or offensive.
