

Restricted Uses of School Buildings

No school building or grounds shall be used for any of the following purposes:

- a. For commercial or personal gain except as specified below
- b. For any program including any form of gambling
- c. For any private classes for the instruction of children of school age unless such classes are deemed by the superintendent to be a suitable supplement to the regular instructional program of the schools. The schedules of charges, the qualifications of the teachers, and the quality of instruction shall conform to standards established by the superintendent of schools and the classes shall be operated by a non-profit agency
- d. For any other instruction for which any charge is made unless such instruction is part of a program under the direction of the school authorities or of some approved public or community agency, or unless the charge is made solely to meet the expenses incidental to the instruction and the teacher is paid on an hourly rather than on a commission basis
- e. For any group instruction sponsored by an individual, corporation or profit-making organization whereby fees collected accrue solely or largely to the benefit of the sponsor
- f. For any money-raising activity unless the proceeds thereof are used for school purposes or for approved charitable, educational, character-building, or other community welfare purposes
- g. For any money-raising activity, regardless of the use to be made of the proceeds thereof, if any of the goods or services utilized in said activity are purchased on a commission or percentage basis except as provided in Section 3258
- h. For engendering racial or religious prejudices or for any other purposes inimical to our democratic way of life

In order that the foregoing restrictions may be effectively enforced, the applicant for any permit for an activity other

than a school activity which involves the receipt of money shall set forth in writing as a part of the application the nature and schedule of charges or other receipts and the anticipated use or uses of the proceeds, and shall subsequently furnish a report setting forth the amount and nature of the receipts and the use made thereof.
