### Community-School Concept

The Cincinnati Public Recreation Commission, and the Board of Education in carrying out their separate responsibilities have, through the years, worked together on numerous common endeavors.

Each of these boards endorses the "community-school concept," a philosophy under which school and recreation authorities join together to maximize public service, pool community resources and effect economies through cooperative and coordinated planning, facility acquisition and development, use, maintenance, financing and programming.

These boards recognize the importance of identifying, preserving, and acquiring sites for expansion of their services commensurate with the growth of residential development.

The Cincinnati Public Recreation Commission and the Board of Education hereby jointly adopt as official policy the "community-school concept" and agree to expand their working relationships and to devise plans for initiating and implementing that policy.
