

Payment of Fees and Other Charges

Fees and other charges shall be paid in U.S. coin and currency, certified check, money order, cashier's check, or debit/credit card. Personal checks are not acceptable for the payment of fees and other charges.

No student shall be denied any educational opportunity or official record of achievement because of the student's inability to pay any fee or charge imposed, except a tuition fee.

In order to improve the student's ability to pay, and in order to meet the individual circumstances of a student, the Superintendent shall establish procedures which permit alternatives to the partial, full or prompt payment of the Instructional Supply Fee. Such alternatives shall be available to students who state in writing the circumstances which prevent such payment and propose an alternative which is justified to the circumstances and acceptable to the school's principal. Students shall be informed in advance that all such statements shall be afforded confidential treatment.
