

Sale of Merchandise to Pupils

Stationery supplies, workbooks, protective clothing, or similar items related to school activities may be offered for sale or rent through a school bookstore as a convenience to pupils. If the operation of a school bookstore seems inadvisable, other appropriate arrangements may be made for the sale or rental of these items.

Such items shall be priced at not to exceed cost, including transportation, plus a markup of no more than ten percent.

Sanitary supplies and related items may be sold at cost under the supervision of a person designated by the principal. In case vending machines are used, the price may be as indicated thereon, and any profits accruing from sales shall be used for the operation of rest rooms or for similar purposes.

A principal may, not more than once a year, permit a photographer to take class, group, or individual pictures and sell copies thereof of pupils.

Monies derived from such sales or rentals as are authorized in this section shall be student activity funds, and may be used to finance student activities or for other purposes for the benefit of pupils within the school.
