

Disposition of Surplus Buildings and Grounds

Prior to buildings and grounds being declared surplus by formal action of the board, the superintendent shall determine the appropriateness for future or alternate uses. The superintendent shall develop administrative procedures to implement this policy. The board retains final approval for disposition or usage change for any real property. If there should be some compelling need in a community for the use of a school facility for other than school purposes, the benefits of which are considered to be greater than the benefits that could be realized from the sale of the property, consideration will be given to a proposal for alternative use. If the board declares a property surplus, it shall be disposed of according to law.
