

Memorials in School Buildings or on School Grounds

No individual or group of individuals shall be permitted to erect any honor roll, memorial, or other structure of any kind in a school building or upon school grounds, except by special permission of the board of education. Such permission will not be granted for any permanent structure unless it has utilitarian value in the operation of the school plant, and/or it is erected in memory of some individual or group of individuals who have been associated with the school either as pupils or employees.

Permission to erect any temporary structure shall be given only on condition that the structure will be removed within a reasonable time and that the premises will be restored to the condition in which found.
