

School Meetings, Free Permits

Whenever it will not interfere unduly with the regular program of the schools, the school facilities may be used for any meeting, program, entertainment, or other activity sponsored by the school authorities, by any parent-teacher or similar association, by any recognized group of school employees, or by any approved character-building youth group.

The superintendent shall establish certain hours during which such meetings or other activities may be conducted without charge to the user, it being the intention of the board of education that such free use of school facilities be confined insofar as possible to the times when additional heat, electricity, and employee service are not required. Whenever a building is used outside the hours thus established, a charge shall be made to cover the extra heat, electricity, and employee service involved.

The superintendent may establish a limited number of free permits to be allowed each year outside of said hours to a school, to a parent-teacher or similar association, or to a recognized group of school employees, and no charge shall be made for the use of school facilities under such free permits. After the quota of free permits has been exhausted, the school or organization using the facilities shall pay a fee to cover the cost of any additional heat, electricity, and employee service required by reason of such use of the facilities.
