

Alcoholic Beverage Permit Restriction

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to oppose the issuance of any alcoholic beverage permit which allows the sale of such products for consumption on the premises where sold to any business operated within a distance of 500 feet from the boundaries of a parcel of the Board's real estate whereon a school building or playground is located; except in the case of an application for a permit to sell alcoholic beverage of a lower alcoholic content than the one now possessed, except (see Section 4303.26, Ohio Revised Code) for the renewal of a permit at the same location without change of class, and except when a change in ownership of a business does not involve a change in class of a permit. The Board of Education's general counsel will arrange for and represent the district at a hearing with the Department of Liquor Control.
