Reading



- Hear, say and read all the letters in the alphabet.
- Hear and say different word sounds and read short words.
- Read books and poems that repeat and rhyme.
- Look at signs and pictures to learn new words.
- Use different ways to tell a story.

Writing



- Show writing through playing, drawing and painting.
- Write my own name and other words I use often.
- Write about a topic I choose and reread what I write.

Research



- Ask questions about what I'm learning and share what I find.

Communication



- Listen to stories, songs and poetry and connect them to what I know.
- Tell the events of a story or things that happen to me in order, using "first," "next," and "last."
- Listen and follow directions.
- Speak clearly and recite short poems, songs and rhymes.
