## History



- Use a calendar to tell the day, week, month and year.
- Create a simple time line.
- Understand basic human needs and how they are met in different ways at different times.

## People in Societies



- Identify and describe different cultures, their contributions and influences.

## Geography



- Identify oceans, continents—as well as the United States and Ohio—on maps.
- Explain how the environment influences the way people live.

## Economics



- Explain how people make choices to get items that they need and want.
- Understand the difference between goods and services.

## Government



- Identify elected leaders and explain how local government works.
- Explain the importance of symbols and landmarks of the United States.
- Explain the purpose of rules.

## Citizenship Rights & Responsibilities



- Work cooperatively in groups and take responsibility for my actions.

## Social Studies Skills & Methods



- Conduct research using different types of sources.
- Communicate information orally, visually or in writing.
- Work in groups to solve problems.
