Description of Services

UC SES has the capacity and resources to deliver a high-quality, research-based tutoring program aligned with state standards. The University of Cincinnati has invested in district approved curriculum which is an extension of the classroom Voyager curriculum. In addition, each student placed with UC SES will be given access to an on-line curriculum, My Skills Tutor. Students are encouraged to access this resource outside of scheduled tutoring sessions so their progress can be reviewed with the tutor at their next tutor session. UC SES is committed to student success. UC SES tutors will help students attain this ideal. Highly qualified tutors will guide students to understand content and learning strategies that will empower students to become creative, independent learners and problem solvers. UC SES provides Math and Reading tutoring under the supervision of a team of curriculum specialists in teacher education. Due to the large pool of highly qualified graduate students, staff and faculty associated with the university, UC SES can readily develop individualized academic interventions to support students in attaining grade-level competencies. Enrichment opportunities are integrated into all student learning plans. University of Cincinnati has the capacity to effectively respond to a diverse student population and their specific learning abilities. There is a consultation team available to support UC SES tutors. The consultation team meets to offer expertise and solutions to any learning issue or challenge that requires additional support. Another feature offered to our students is the experience of attending tutoring sessions at the University of Cincinnati on designated "Tutoring at UC" days. Students have the unique opportunity to experience campus life. On these specific dates, UC SES offers access to state of the art computer labs and some tutor sessions are scheduled in conference rooms equipped with interactive smartboards. UC SES takes advantage of every opportunity when CPS students attend "Tutoring at UC" by offering additional time which does not count against their 36 tutoring hours so that students have campus exposure via a college tour, meals at Centre Court and a recreational activity. Anytime a student has the opportunity to be on a college campus, it increases their awareness of a college education becoming a reality. Transportation is provided for students attending "Tutoring at UC" specified days.

Description of Services

The After School League is a tutorial service that provides assistance to K-8 grade students in the core subjects of Reading/Language Arts and Mathematics. The After School League will provide high-quality tutoring to students to help them perform at or above their academic grade level by offering a 1:5 tutor/student ratio and a personalized learning curriculum. Program schedules vary by location, but most programs operate after school, 2 to 5 times per week for 1 to 2.5 hours per day. Students are strongly encouraged to attend tutoring at least 1 to 1.5 hours for 2-5 days a week to meet desired results. Additional tutoring is available during school breaks.

Victory Equipping Center provides tutorial services in math and reading to students in grades K through 12.
