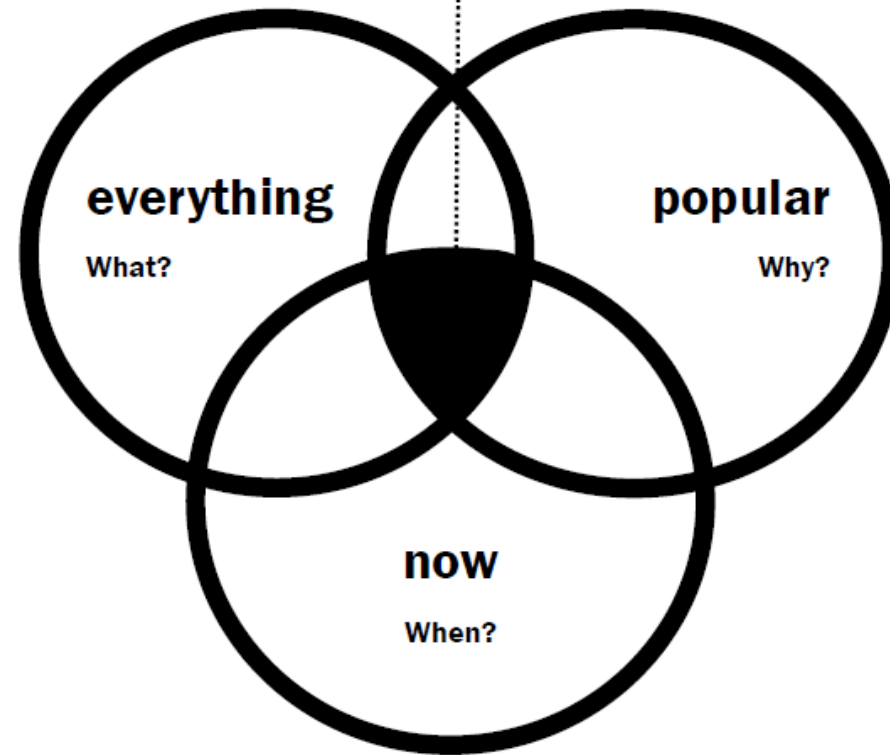

Highest Point of Frustration



District Supported Full Distance Learning Cincinnati Digital Academy (CDA)

- Enrollment increased from 480 last year to ~1700 currently
- Investments made in additional staff
- Offering extended time and online options for some classes (e.g., Latin 3)

Full Distance Learning from Current School

- **Three days on same schedule as class:**
 - Monday (distance learning)
 - A/B cohort at-home days (Tues/Weds or Thurs/Fri)
- **Two A/B cohort in-person days:**
 - These students may access lessons via Schoology

Access to Schoology

- Teachers assign students distance Schoology Lessons
- Students login every day
- Use the weekly updates and lessons to pace themselves
- Teachers grade and provide feedback
