

Kilgour Elementary Alumni Scholarship

The Kilgour Elementary Alumni Scholarship is a \$1,000 scholarship given by the Kilgour PTA to a deserving high school senior. The recipient must have attended Kilgour Elementary for at least 3 years and graduated from the 6th grade at Kilgour Elementary. The scholarship is awarded on the basis of community involvement and demonstrated leadership skills. While academic achievement is not a specific focus of this award, the recipient must maintain at least a 2.5 High School grade point average. Just as Kilgour Elementary seeks to give students a well-rounded education, the Kilgour PTA also seeks to reward a well-rounded High School senior who is able to reflect on their years at Kilgour and demonstrate how that foundation education has impacted him/her. The \$1,000 scholarship may be used for college, professional training, or other educational pursuits.

Deadline: The deadline for the submission of completed applications for each school year is **April 15.**

Method of Selection:

The Kilgour School PTA Scholarship Committee will consist of five (5) parents, one (1) teacher, and one (1) non-reading, non-voting chairperson. The committee will conduct blind reviews of the applicants; only the chairperson will know the applicants' names. Parents and teachers <u>cannot</u> be scholarship application reviewers if their child, step-child, or other relative is an applicant. It is acceptable for the Chairperson to be related to an applicant because this position is a *non-reading*, *non-voting* position.

Each reviewer will rate each application on a scale of 0-40 points. Reviewers will give up to 10 points in each of the following areas:

- Community Involvement
- Essay 1 (Educational and Career Objectives)
- Essay 2 (Kilgour Impact)
- Teacher Letter of Recommendation

Transcripts will not be reviewed by the committee. The non-voting chairperson will assign points for unweighted grade point average in the following manner:

- 2.5 2.9 = 3 points
- 3.0 3.4 = 6 points
- 3.5 3.9 = 9 points

• 4.0 = 10 points

In the event of a tie, the Kilgour PTA President (or their designee on the PTA board) will blindly review the tied applications to determine the winner.

Procedure for Receiving Scholarship:

All applicants will be notified by mail that their applications have been received and reviewed and that a winner has been selected. The winner will receive a congratulatory letter from the Kilgour School PTA Scholarship Committee. The scholarship award will be presented to the recipient at the May Kilgour PTA meeting, and announced at end of the year assemblies and the Kilgour Carnival. The scholarship recipient may be invited to attend other Kilgour events, such as the 6th Grade Moving Up Ceremony. Information from the winning scholarship application may be used in announcements of the award of the scholarship. The scholarship will be paid directly to the recipient.
