

HB123 Prevention Education Opt-Out Form

Sign & Return ONLY if opting out

Ohio's 133rd General Assembly enacted <u>House Bill 123</u>, the "Safety and Violence Education Students (SAVE Students) Act," regarding school security and youth suicide awareness education and training. The state legislation calls for a comprehensive approach to school safety involving the Ohio departments of Education, Public Safety, Mental Health and Addiction Services and Attorney General's Office. Emotional and physical safety requirements include integrating evidence-based suicide awareness and violence prevention and social inclusion into health curriculum.

Ohio law provides for changes to the prescribed curriculum specific to health education beginning July 1, 2023. Starting in the 2023-2024 school year, in every grade level from grades 6 through 12 and continuing each subsequent year, schools must include at least one hour (or one standard class period) per school year of evidence-based instruction in each of the following topics:

- 1. Suicide awareness and prevention:
- 2. Safety training and violence prevention; and
- 3. Social inclusion.

Because our Montessori classrooms include grades 4, 5, and 6 together, we are offering these lessons to our 4th and 5th grade students as well as our 6th grade students during their SEL Wellness special class three times throughout the year. The first lesson will be about social inclusion. The second lesson will be about safety and violence prevention. The third lesson will be about suicide awareness and prevention. All topics are presented with age appropriate materials/discussion.

Upon written request of the student's parent or guardian, a student shall be excused from taking instruction in the areas of suicide awareness and prevention, safety training and violence prevention, and social isolation.
