Dear Families,

It is my goal this year to have a kinder and better relationship with our environment by increasing awareness, taking actionable steps to becoming a greener classroom by reducing the amount of trash in our room. We will be using washcloths and prepared, safe cleaning spray instead of wipes for daily table washing and common surface areas; we will use clean ones each day and the washcloths will be washed and sanitized weekly. To assist in controlling a healthy environment, students will also continue to have basic tools and supplies kept in their own pencil bag or box. (I have pencils, crayons and glue sticks already for everyone.)

Everyone:* Please **do not** put any names on any of these supplies unless noted*

- A backpack to carry every day to school
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 large package or bundle of washcloths (for daily table washing and common surface areas; these will be washed and sanitized as a large load weekly.)
- 1 black composition notebook, (100 pages)
- 1 durable pencil bag or supply box - *with name (to hold their basic supplies)
- 1 pack colored pencils
- 1 pack thin tip Crayola Washable Markers
- 1 pack wide tip Crayola Washable Markers
- 2 bar erasers
- 1 pack black dry erase markers - Expo brand lasts longer
- an old lonely sock or a cut square of soft fabric for a dry eraser

By Grade Level: *Please **do not** put any names.

First year only - 2 quality two-pocket folders with prongs - **1 Green, 1 Yellow**

Second year only - 2 quality two-pocket folders with prongs - **1 Blue, 1 Purple**

Third year only - 2 quality two-pocket folders with prongs - **1 Red, 1 Orange**

Optional extras:

An effective all-purpose cleaner safe for children to use; It can be a concentrate to be diluted in a spray bottle when we clean our tables

- Clorox wipes for when needed
