The Cincinnati Public Schools seek to provide the best facilities that can be obtained from all available resources. [The Board of Education strives to create school campus / learning center environments that foster student academic achievement and maximize community involvement.](#)

Changing educational needs requires planning, design, renovations and additions to existing facilities, construction of new facilities, demolition and sale of some facilities and maintenance of all educational facilities.

- A. Technical and design standards and supporting repair and maintenance procedures are to be developed for all Cincinnati Public School facilities using industry best practices and the Ohio Department of Education facilities commission standards and justifications, as revised and amended by the Cincinnati Public Schools.
- B. In accordance with Ohio law and to the extent possible based on best practices, the district shall establish a capital and maintenance fund to provide for necessary repairs, maintenance and supporting organization.
- C. A regularly scheduled visit of facilities will be established to review, monitor and maintain quality in every facility. The visit should be used to develop priorities for the deployment of maintenance funds.
- D. Public and community input is ~~encouraged and comments should be directed through appropriate CPS channels.~~ [essential to creating successful school campuses.](#)
