

## 2020-21 Special College Preparatory Program (SCPP) Exam TESTING SCHEDULE

For Entrance to Walnut Hills High School in the 2021-2022 school year.

Administered to students currently enrolled in Grades 6-11. Each student can take the SCPP exam a maximum of two times in a school year. Students needing to retest must wait two months after the first attempt to take their second attempt.

Students retesting may retest in one or both parts of the SCPP exam. The highest scores from both attempts will be used for the composite score. Students must have a minimum composite national percentile rank score of 140 across the Reading Total and Math Total scores-- with a minimum of a 65th percentile rank on each part.

***Registration for 2020-2021 testing will take place at [register.cps-k12.org](http://register.cps-k12.org) beginning on September 1, 2020.***

CPS 6th Grade students take the SCPP Exam at their CPS building between 9/21/20-10/16/20 as part of Ohio's Districtwide Gifted Screening. These students are not permitted to sign up for an October or November date unless they were unable to test at their schools between 9/21-10/16.

  - Registration Deadline (including Out-of-District Fee and/or Documentation): September 29th at 5:00 p.m. EST
- **Saturday, November 21, 2020 @ Walnut Hills High School**
  - Registration Deadline (including Out-of-District Fee and/or Documentation): October 27th at 5:00 p.m. EST

### First Time Test & Retest Dates

- **Saturday, January 9, 2021 @ Walnut Hills High School**
  - Registration Deadline (including Out-of-District Fee and/or Documentation): December 11th at 5:00 p.m. EST
- **Saturday, February 13, 2021 @ Walnut Hills High School**
  - Registration Deadline (including Out-of-District Fee and/or Documentation): January 15th at 5:00 p.m. EST

Students unable to attend a Saturday testing date due to a religious conflict may arrange for a Thursday test in October (10/8) or January (1/14). Please contact the Testing and Assessment Department to determine eligibility. Students testing on a Thursday will need written permission from their school principal prior to testing.
