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Cincinnati Public Schools Important Information for High School Application

For 2022-2023 School Year

This paper application is for use only for the following students:

- Current non-CPS students attending private, charter or home schools who live within CPS' district boundaries and who want to enter CPS' high schools in the upper grades (10, 11, 12)
- Current CPS students who want to change high schools in the upper grades (10, 11, 12)

Who does not use this paper application:

- Students now attending a CPS elementary school in grades 6, 7 and 8, or their parents/guardians, must apply to CPS' high schools through the district's **online lottery application system** from any Internet-connected computer.
- Non-CPS students who live within CPS' district boundaries and attend a non-CPS elementary school (private, charter or home schools) apply to CPS' high schools through the **online lottery application system**, but **parents/guardians of non-CPS students must come to CPS' Customer Care Center**, 2651 Burnet Avenue, in Corryville (45219), to submit the online application.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, CPS' Customer Care Center is open to visits from the public with walk-in visits and appointments. Appointments are available 7:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

- Students are expected to remain in their selected high school programs for the entire 2022-2023 school year.
- All Cincinnati Public Schools' high schools are open to students with disabilities. If your child requires specialized placement, call CPS' Department of Student Services: (513) 363-0357
- Applicants who reside east of Interstate 75 will have priority into Clark Montessori High School and applicants who reside west of Interstate 75 will have priority into James N. Gamble Montessori High School.
- **Waiting lists at high schools exist until June 30.**
